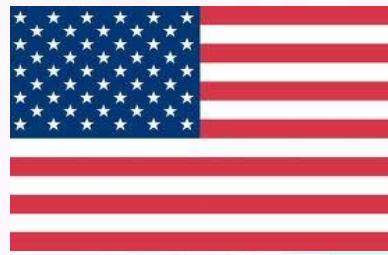

7. Negotiations are on with all these corporations to make this World Congress a remarkable learning experience.



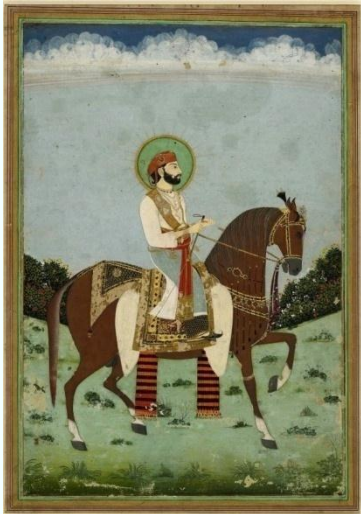


## JAIPUR

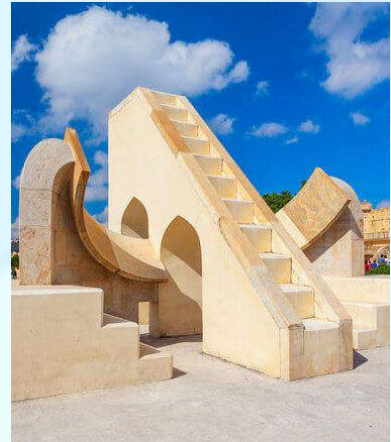

The Hawa Mahal is another 5 storied pyramidal monument with 953 windows. And there is much more.



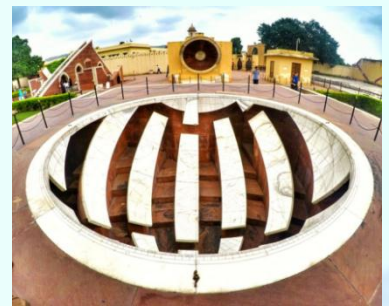
